Eastglen is part of an exciting pilot project in Edmonton Public Schools, called Campus EPSB. It involves a partnership between Eastglen, M.E. LaZerte and Queen Elizabeth High Schools.

This initiative will run in semester two, and will allow our students the opportunity to access some specialized courses unique to each one of our schools. For this pilot year, we will focus primarily on grade 11 students.

This is what the programming will look like:

- Eastglen will be offering an Advanced Performing and Visual Arts program (one that our PVA team has put together)
- M.E. LaZerte will be offering steel work, which will give interested students access to specialized programming around welding
- Queen Elizabeth will be offering advanced computer programming

Interested students will apply to the program they are interested in. While students will remain connected to their current school, this will allow them to experience something above and beyond what they are currently receiving at their school. Once the semester ends, the students are required to return to their original school. More information will be shared about this initiative.
