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I am pleased to say we completed our required three Evacuation Drills and one Lockdown Practice.

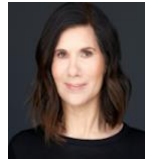
These drills serve to reinforce expectations and safety practices for our students and staff. I greatly appreciate how well our team has performed practicing these drills.
