Emergency Procedures

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To support the safety of our students and staff, we will be reviewing with our students their designated locations in the event we need to evacuate the school. Such situations could be related to a gas leak or a fire drill. The designated locations are the same as listed on the map for Teacher Door Designations, already shared on SchoolZone. Our goal is to familiarize our students with these muster points in the event of an emergency. Should we ever need to move from our Muster points outside of the school, our alternate emergency location is Highlands Jr High School. As per EPSB Policy, we will be conducting 3 fire drill practices this Fall, with our first drill being later this week.

We will also review our Lockdown Procedures. This type of drill is used in the event there is an intruder in the school or community and we need to lock the school down to protect the safety of everyone in our building. We will also be having our first lockdown drill this week.

In the event of an actual emergency our first goal will be ensuring the safety and well-being of our students and staff. Once that has been established we will then communicate out to families via SchoolZone – only when it is safe to do so. Should you have any questions please feel free to reach out to Mr. Fox.
